Cultural social ticket: culture for 1 euro

Do you like going to the theatre or a museum? Would you like to go to a concert? But you don't have much money?

The city of Augsburg wants all citizens to be able to take part in cultural life. For people who have little money, there is the Kultursozialticket. For these people, a ticket to many cultural events and museums costs just 1 euro.

Who receives the Kultursozialticket?

- The Kultursozialticket is available to anyone who has a Tafel card.
- People who have a social ticket can also use the Kultursozialticket.

Where can I get the Kultursozialticket?

Table card

The Tafelausweis is valid as a Kultursozialticket. You can obtain the Tafelausweis from [Augsburger Tafel e. V.](#)

- If you receive citizen's allowance.
- If you receive basic income support.
- If you receive social welfare.
- If you have a low old-age pension.
- If you receive housing benefit.
- If you are studying and receive BAföG.
- If you live in a poor financial situation.

Social ticket

The social ticket is important for public transport (ÖPNV). If you have a Sozialticket, you can buy the [Deutschland-Ticket](#) at a reduced price. Together with the social ticket you will receive an authorisation certificate. This voucher is valid as a cultural social ticket.

How does the Kultursozialticket work?

Do you have a Tafel card or a certificate of eligibility?

- Show the card or voucher at the ticket office. You will receive your ticket for the price of 1 euro.

- You can get your ticket at the box office. You can buy your ticket 20 minutes before the event. Reservations are not possible.
- You CANNOT buy a Kultursozialticket for the premieres.

Clubs in Augsburg

Association - what is it?

Clubs are very important in Germany. This is where people who have the same interests and goals come together.

What exactly is an association?

An association is a group of people. They want to achieve or do the same thing. It can be the same hobby, e.g. sport. But it can also be the same goals, e.g. climate protection or helping people in need.

An association should exist permanently, not just for a short time. The people in the association are called members.

What clubs are there in Augsburg?

- Augsburg has over 200 **sports clubs** for a wide variety of sports. Here are a few examples: American football, basketball, mountain sports, boxing, canoe slalom, gymnastics, swimming, volleyball, yoga and much more...

There are well over 100 so-called **migrant organisations (MO)** in Augsburg. These organisations were founded by immigrants.

They facilitate contact with fellow countrymen. They have a wide variety of orientations, such as religious, cultural, political or for joint leisure activities.

How do I become a member of an association?

- You must complete an **application** form. Each association has its own form for this.
- Membership of an association costs an **annual fee**. The clubs themselves decide how high the annual fee is.
There are often more favourable rates for children.

💡 You have little money and your child would like to join a club? Sometimes the city of Augsburg pays the annual fee for your child.

Ask the [Amt für Soziale Leistungen](#) for benefits from the education and participation package.

What advantages does a club have for me?

- You meet people with the same hobbies and interests.
- You get to know new people.
- You can get involved with others in the same cause.
- You learn something new about your interests.
- Club programmes are usually only for members.
- Club offers are cheaper than commercial offers.
- You can get involved in the club and take on responsibility.
- You can do something good for yourself and others.

Are there special programmes for children in clubs?

Many clubs have groups for children and families. Parents do not always have to be members. In some clubs you can only register your children. Children can do sports, dance, sing and learn to swim in clubs, for example. Trained coaches accompany your children.

Child protection in the club (Verein)

Child protection is very important in Germany. It means that all children have rights. They should grow up healthy and happy. Adults must ensure this. This includes parents, but also educators, teachers and volunteers (e.g. coaches) in clubs.

Clubs should be places of protection for children and young people. This means that children should feel comfortable and safe in clubs. They should play, do sport and make friends here. They should have a say in decision-making, experience success and thus strengthen their self-confidence.

- Clubs sign an agreement with Amt für Kinder, Jugend und Familie.
- Together with the employees, the clubs draw up a [protection concept](#).
- Clubs check the criminal records of volunteers who work with children and young people.
- Organisations offer special training courses for volunteers who work with children and young people.

- They provide help in emergencies and crisis situations.

💡 **Very important:** If you can't swim, never go into the water deeper than your knees! Many people drown every year because they can't swim. They don't realise that it is very dangerous to go into a river or lake.

Rivers and lakes

If you like swimming in lakes, Augsburg has a choice of four bathing lakes. Swimming in rivers is also permitted. Swimming in canals is generally not permitted. There are only a few exceptions.

Kuhsee

Kuhsee has very good water quality. The water rescue centre is manned at weekends. There are barbecue areas, three kiosks and a restaurant with boat hire on the shore. It was given the name Kuhsee because in the past, herds of cows were led here to drink. The water quality of the Kuhsee is very good.

Bergheimer Baggersee

The small, idyllic Bergheimer Baggersee is beautifully situated in the west of Augsburg. A visit can be wonderfully combined with a cycle tour along the Wertach or in the western forests. Lifeguards from the Göggingen water rescue service are on site at weekends. The lake has very good water quality.

Motorway lake

Here you will find large sunbathing lawns, shady trees and several barbecue areas. Many people like to come here to swim. The lake has very good water quality.

You can swim in unchlorinated water at Naturfreibad Haunstetten. The lake has very good water quality. The lake is over 10,000 square metres in size. There is also a kiosk, a beach volleyball court and a children's playground on site.

A lake for divers and swimmers. It has spacious sunbathing areas for relaxing. At weekends, the Königsbrunn water rescue service ensures safe swimming.

Swimming in rivers is permitted. Swimming in canals is generally not permitted. There are only a few exceptions. Sunbathing lawns designated by the Office for Green Regulations are regularly mowed and cleaned. Unlike bathing lakes, there are no lifeguards on site.
