



Sexually transmitted infections (STIs)

What are sexually transmitted infections (STIs)?

Sexually transmitted diseases are infections that can be contracted during sex. For example, you can become infected through unprotected sex or close physical contact. These diseases are also known as STIs. This is the abbreviation for: Sexually transmitted infections.

There are many types of STI. For example:

- HIV can weaken the immune system.
- Chlamydia can cause pain or infertility.
- Syphilis often starts with a small, painless rash.
- Gonorrhoea (gonorrhoea) can cause discharge and burning when urinating.
- HPV a virus that can cause warts or cancer.

Please note!

- Many STIs do not cause any symptoms at first.
- It is therefore possible to be infected without realising it.
- You can then pass on the disease unnoticed.

What can you do?

- Use condoms they provide good protection against many STIs.
- Have yourself tested regularly, especially if you are infected Go to a counselling centre.
