They will clarify whether you still need a professional qualification or a German course. They will inform you about suitable offers. They will support you with your application and work with you to find an internship. The job counsellors will continue to support you once you have found a job.

Who can contact job counsellors?

The job counsellors will advise and support you if you are over 25 years old and belong to one of the following groups:

- · Asylum seekers with good prospects of remaining in Germany
- Tolerated persons with good prospects of staying
- · Recognised asylum seekers
- · People with a migration background

The job counsellors will advise you on the following questions and topics:

- Are you looking for training, employment or school education?
- Do you have questions about career guidance?
- · Are you looking for information on the labour market?
- Would you like to gain further qualifications?
- Would you like to learn how to write a job application in Germany?
