

## Krankenhäuser

If you need a doctor at night, on weekends or on holidays, but it is not an emergency, the on-call medical service is there for you.

At the number **C**all **<u>116117</u>** to find out where the nearest emergency medical service is located.

You can visit an on-call practice without an appointment during opening hours. They will ensure that patients with urgent medical needs receive outpatient treatment even outside of regular office hours.

If you experience severe pain on weekends, holidays, or when doctor's offices are closed (for example, at night), go to the hospital. Hospitals also have emergency rooms open on weekends.

A hospital (= clinic or clinic) is a house where very sick people are treated. A large number of doctors and nurses work in a hospital. You only go to a hospital if you are very sick or seriously injured. You go to a hospital when an emergency occurs.

In the clinic, you can't choose your doctor. You'll be in a room with other people.

The health insurance company covers the costs of hospital treatment, accommodation and food. However, you have to pay a daily allowance of €10 for each day.

On't forget your ID or proof of arrival when you go to the hospital! If you are registered with a health insurance company, please also bring your insurance card with you.

Q As an asylum seeker, you are only allowed to go to hospital without a treatment certificate in the event of an emergency.

At the hospital, you must show with your proof of arrival that you are an asylum seeker and the costs will be billed through the social welfare office.
