The job centre will help you with

- Citizen's allowance (money for people without work)
- Job search
- Further training & qualification

Who can get citizen's allowance?

You can apply for Citizen's Income if you:

- can work but need help.
- ✓ have a foreign passport and fulfil the requirements.

Special rules for foreigners:

- People from the EU must be considered employees. The check is complicated.
- People from non-EU countries need a residence permit or a fictitious certificate.
- ${\mathbin{\rm \Delta}}$ No citizen's allowance with a residence permit or tolerated stay!

Important information

Do you have a residence permit or tolerated stay permit? Then you must register with the Federal Employment Agency. The job centre can give you non-binding advice.

How can the job centre help?

- Money for rent & living expenses
- Counselling & support
- Job search & placement
- Further training & language courses
- Help with the recognition of certificates & qualifications
- Counselling for problems (e.g. debt, addiction)
