The school social workers offer help and support in everyday school life, but also in crisis situations. In this way, we create conditions that enable children and young people to succeed in their everyday school lives.

Its tasks include:

- Group programmes (e.g. programmes to strengthen the class community, social skills training, prevention projects, teaching conflict resolution strategies)
- Individual case support (support and counselling for pupils and their parents/guardians)
- Collaboration in school development
- · Support with school projects
