

Parks and squares

Bocholt has many public sports grounds, playgrounds and parks. You can play there with your children and go for a walk. You can also do sports or relax there.

Aasee Bocholt

The Bocholter Aasee is a large recreational area for all citizens. You can **swim** there in summer. You can also go **surfing** or **sailing** there. There is a circular path around the Aasee that is suitable for running or **jogging**. At one point there is an **exercise park** with sports equipment. You can try out various sports exercises there. There is a **climbing garden** and a large **playground** for children at the Aasee.

Bocholt city forest

The Bocholt city forest is a 69-hectare **forest** with many recreational opportunities. Ponds, walking paths, **animal enclosures** with wild boar, goats and deer as well as a **playground** for children invite you to visit. In winter, the **toboggan hill** is a popular meeting place for sledging in the snow.

Bürgerpark Mosse

The Bürgerpark Mosse consists of three lakes and a circuit for **walking** or **running**. Important: **swimming here is life-threatening** and therefore forbidden.

Langenbergpark

Langenbergpark is a park near Bocholt city centre. There are many sports facilities in Langenbergpark, such as multifunctional fields for **playing football or basketball**. There are also large **climbing frames** for children. You can go for a **walk** or run around the Langenbergpark.
