

The Burgenlandkreis answers questions about Corona vaccination

Currently, the authorities in the Burgenlandkreis are closed to visitors. This is expected to apply until 19 March 2022.

Do I have to get vaccinated?

No. Vaccination is voluntary. However, corona vaccination is recommended. This is how you protect yourself from getting sick. You also protect the others.

Do I need an appointment?

Currently, anyone can get vaccinated without an appointment at the vaccination centres.

Can I also get vaccinated by my family doctor?

Corona vaccination is also available from your GP.

What documents do I need to bring with me to the vaccination appointment?

Valid identity document

Vaccination card (if you have one)

Important medical records, such as: Heart passport, diabetic card or medication list (if available).

How does the vaccination work?

First they check whether you are allowed to be vaccinated. A clarification form must be filled out. A doctor asks if you are ill. He will also answer your questions about vaccination. After you have signed the information form, you will be vaccinated. Then wait 15 min for medical monitoring.

FFP2 masks are mandatory in the vaccination centre.

You will receive a vaccination certificate.


3 weeks after the first vaccination there is the second vaccination . The vaccination only protects reliably 2 weeks after the second vaccination. You will be informed of the second vaccination date in writing on site.

For everyone's protection, please continue to follow the AHA rules after vaccination: Distance, hygiene, everyday mask.
