Refugee social services in shared accommodation centres (DRK)

The city of Freiburg is responsible for the residential centres for refugees. The DRK-Kreisverband Freiburg e.V. provides social services in five hostels, making it the largest independent organisation providing social services for refugees. The hostels in Bissierstraße, Hirschengarten, Kappler Knoten, Mooswaldallee and Tel-Aviv-Yafo-Allee have different capacities.

The DRK-Kreisverband Freiburg e.V. helps refugees in these five shared accommodation centres in Freiburg. People flee their countries because they are being persecuted or are afraid of war and violence. Most of them are allowed to stay in Germany.
