Hagen has been one of the most important study locations in Germany for many years. Hagen is home to Germany's first and only state distance-learning university. At the FernUniversität 69,982 students are enrolled (as of March 2023). With almost 70,000 students, the FernUniversität Hagen is one of the three largest universities in Germany. The degrees awarded by the Fernuniversität are regular university degrees. It awards Bachelor's and Master's degrees. All faculties have the right to award doctorates and habilitations. The Fernuniversität in Hagen also offers preparatory courses, academic studies and partial studies for professional or personal development. The tasks of the Fernuniversität include teaching, studying, research and continuing education. The faculties cover a wide range of study programmes.
