"Assisted living" supports young adults in becoming independent in their own living space.

Victim-offender mediation (TOA)

Are you involved in a criminal offence as the accused or the injured party? There is the possibility of an out-of-court settlement, the victim-offender mediation after a crime. In this process, the injured party and the accused find their own way to a mutually satisfactory settlement. This can be, for example, reparation, compensation for pain and suffering or an agreement for the future.

They receive support from professional mediators.

The mediation is free of charge. A settlement in conversation usually makes criminal and civil proceedings superfluous.
