#### German for Adults and Work

In order to find your way in Germany, you should learn German. For an apprenticeship or employment you need the language level B1 or higher. There are different ways to learn German. The residence status determines which option you can choose.

There are a wide range of language course offerings in the Hochtaunuskreis, which covers many needs. It may be advised to take several levels of language support until the integration course should be attended. **The integration course can only be attended once**.

## **Volunteer Language Courses**

Besides the official German courses, there are many opportunities to practice German in the Hochtaunuskreis.

The groups are led by volunteers. These are mostly people whose mother tongue is German. Sometimes it is teachers who are no longer working. Anyone can join these groups, regardless of their residence status.

You can obtain information on this from the town hall at your place of residence.

Advice on German courses for adults is also offered, for example, from the <u>Migration Advice for Adults</u> and the <u>Youth Migration Service</u>.

# **Initial Orientation Courses for Refugees**

Initial Orientation for Refugees

- · for adults in receipt of benefits under the AsylbLG and with unclear prospects of staying.
- Initial language skills are taught to help people find their way in everyday life.
- Six teaching modules are offered, each comprising 50 teaching units (TU).
- The aim of the course is to achieve language level A1/A2.
- At least 12 participants are required to start a course.

# Mit-Sprache - Deutsch 4U

For adults with a migration background.

The first language skills are taught in order to orientate oneself in everyday life.

Up to 300 teaching units (UE) are offered.

## Integration courses

Due to a new regulation in §44 of the Residence Act, more people can now apply to the BAMF for an integration course regardless of their residence status. Childcare is not available and must be organized by the applicant. **Participants in an integration course should have a routine in learning!**

# **General Integration Courses**

- 600 units of German lessons up to language level B1
- The integration course is free of charge if you have a low income. An application must be submitted for this.
- A textbook is required to attend the integration course. The cost of the textbook is to be borne by the participant.
- Examination "Deutschtest für Zuwanderer" (DTZ) level A2/B1 only passed with certificate B1
- 100 units of lessons on the structure of the state, history, culture, politics and society in Germany
- Examination "Living in Germany" (LiD)
- If the examination is not passed, an application may be made to repeat 300 units
- If both exams are passed, you will receive the certificate for the integration course

# Repetition

- One repetition on request with 300 hours of lessons:
  Application Repetition Alpha Course 300 hours
- If the "DTZ" exam is failed, no further attendance of an integration course is possible

You may be required to attend an integration course by the <u>lob Centre</u> or by the <u>Aliens</u> <u>Department</u>. If you are not obliged to take part in an integration course but would like to take part in an integration course, you can apply for the integration course at the <u>BAMF</u>. If you need assistance with your application, please contact your <u>social worker</u> or a <u>migration counselling</u> service. They will also support you in selecting an integration course provider.

You can also contact a course provider directly.

# Participation in Integration courses for EU citizens

As an EU citizen, you are not legally entitled to attend an integration course. However, the Federal Office for Migration and Refugees (BAMF) can admit you to an integration course if you





do not yet speak sufficient German, are in particular need of integration and there are free places on the course. To do this, you must complete an application for admission to an integration course.

# Participation in integration courses for late repatriates

If you have been admitted to Germany **since January 1, 2005**, you, your spouse and your children are legally entitled to a free integration course. The costs are covered by the Federal Office for Migration and Refugees. You received your entitlement to participate directly from the Federal Office of Administration in Friedland when you entered Germany.

If you were admitted to Germany **before January 1, 2005** and have not yet attended a language course offered by the Federal Employment Agency (SGB III course), you can attend an integration course free of charge. To do so, please submit an application for an authorization to participate to the Federal Office of Administration. You can send the application by post to the following address:

## Integration courses for young people or illiterate persons

## **Youth Integration Course**

- · For young people up to 26 years of age.
- Here you will learn German for vocational training or work.
- Scope as described for the integration course, but with 900 units of language instruction with vocational orientation.
- If possible an internship should be completed.

# Integration course for learners of second language

- For people who do not know the Latin alphabet, but can read and write in their mother tongue.
- Scope as described for the integration course, but 900 units of language instruction including the teaching of the Latin alphabet in spoken and written form.

# Integration course with literacy

- For people who have no writing skills, even in their mother tongue.
- The task of the literacy course is to bring the participants as close as possible to the goal of literacy within a maximum of 1300 units and at the same time to teach them German.
  - $\mathbb{Q}$  A realistic goal within the framework of maximum support is language level A2.

# **Vocational Language Classes**

# **DeuFöV (Vocational Language Classes)**

- These courses prepare you for vocational training or employment.
- For various professions or training courses, proof of certain language levels is required, e.g. B2 for nurses, C1 for doctors, educators, for university or C2 (teachers).
- Language level C2 can be achieved by attending several courses of 400 or 500 lessons each. If you pass the exam, you will receive a recognized language certificate.
- The prerequisite for attending a course is a successful integration course, a recognized language certificate B1 or school attendance in Germany with at least a secondary school certificate (Hauptschulabschluss).

# DeuFöV-A2 (Spezialmodul)

- A language course for people who have only completed an integration course with language level A2 or can no longer provide proof of a certificate or are no longer admitted to an integration course.
- It offers 400-500 lessons with socio-educational support.
- There is a mandatory examination for language certificate B1.

## Non-working persons

If you are interested in taking part in the vocational language courses, speak to your placement officer at the employment agency or job center.

They will tell you which language schools offer vocational language courses. Your placement officer will issue the necessary certificate of eligibility for participation in a suitable course. Contact a course provider in the Hochtaunuskreis district for registration or advice on DeuFöV.

#### **SPEAK**

SPEAK connects locals and newcomers through language and cultural exchanges and cultural events organized by the community; these activities usually take place in person. SPEAK will organize its language learning groups online using video conferencing. The groups consist of 4 to 6 people and meet for 90 minutes every day of the week for 2 weeks.

Anyone who wants to learn a language and interact with others can register for free with SPEAK. You can learn German, English or any other language you need. You can also find more information on the SPEAK website.

# Online language courses

- Serlo ABC: A free literacy app for self-study or as a supplement to a language course. The app is approved as a textbook for integration courses.

- Basic language course of Deutsche Welle: This online language course contains modules on literacy and job-related language skills. There is also a placement test.

# **Online Study**





Refugees and asylum seekers often face certain difficulties in gaining access to higher education. Kiron Higher Education offers the possibility to study without tuition fees and without the otherwise required legal documents. The problem of limited study places is also being solved. The first two years of the course of study are carried out with online courses via the Internet. All courses are offered in English. But there is the possibility to add subtitles in any language. The third year of studies takes place locally at a partner university of Kiron. In addition, there is the possibility to learn the German language during your studies. Furthermore, various assistance and advice is offered.
