

Germany-wide from October: driving ban for thousands of Ukrainian cars

Ukrainian cars: New rules from 30 September

The special rules for Ukrainian cars in Germany end on 30 September. Vehicles with Ukrainian licence plates will then need a German registration if they have been driving in Germany for more than one year.

This is how registration works

Anyone wishing to register a car must present the vehicle licence from Ukraine, proof of insurance and an identity document in Latin script.

If you ignore the rules, you risk a lot

Without a German registration, you could face fines, penalties and the loss of your operating licence. Anyone who deliberately drives without a licence can face a fine or up to a year in prison.

Important for drivers in Ingolstadt

The <u>driving licence office and the vehicle registration office</u> take care of registrations.
