- To vote in Germany or to be elected as a candidate yourself,
- you must be German.
- There is one exception for EU citizens
- in local election law.
- · However, they must have lived in Germany for at least
- live in Germany for at least five years.

The parties in Germany

Political participation

- Even migrants without a German passport
- it is possible to participate in politics.
