

The district administration of Alzey-Worms has made this Integreat-App available free of charge to help all immigrants and all those providing assistance to immigrants on a full-time or voluntary basis to find their way around. The Integreat-App contains all important information about the District of Alzey-Worms and its services, online and offline. It also contains general political information and everyday aids, references to important documents, and it is updated regularly. The app is available in six languages that can be selected easily.

About Integreat

Integreat is a guide intended to help you with everyday life in Germany. It gives you important addresses and points of contact, as well as tips and tricks that can help you find your way around.

This guide has several chapters. Each section deals with a different subject. For example, you will find information on doctors, schools, German courses and other institutions. There is also a chapter with ideas on what you can do in your spare time. The information and leisure activities change. Your community will update them regularly. So it's a good idea to keep checking your mobile app. This will keep you up to date with the latest activities and events. You can trust that the information in Integreat is reliable.

Download Integreat from your <u>app store</u>. You can also use this app offline if you do not have Internet access. The app will update automatically when you are back online again.

Sharing information

For example, you can download and share important information as a PDF in the web app. In the mobile app, you can share interesting content directly, for example via WhatsApp, Facebook or email.

Latest news

You can also receive push notifications with the Integreat smartphone app. You can agree to receive this in the app settings. Important or last-minute information is sent to you via push notifications.

Feedback

You can contribute to the further development of the Integreat app in your municipality. You can give feedback using the smiley symbols. This information is fed back to the people who create the content. You can praise or criticise. For ideas or criticism, write down as many details as possible. Read aloud function

The content of the Integreat app can also be read aloud. To do this, you will need to switch on the read aloud setting by going to your smartphone's settings. This works in all languages.

We hope this app makes your life in Germany a little bit easier.

Important offices and their tasks

Social Welfare Office (Sozialamt)

The tasks of the Social Welfare Office (Sozialamt) include the provision of social assistance.

This includes the following services:

- · Basic income support for the elderly and in the event of reduced earning capacity
- · Help with care
- · Help with living costs
- · Integration assistance for disabled people
- · Help in overcoming particular social difficulties
- Health support
- · Help in other life situations

The services provided by the "Sozialamt" (Social Welfare Office) also include appropriate advice and support.

At the Social Welfare Office (Sozialamt), you will be asked about your financial situation (for example, whether you have valuables such as jewellery or money). You will sign some documents and statements. Please bring all your papers and all the persons named on your temporary residence permit (Aufenthaltsgestattung) to this appointment.

You will also receive a cheque for your living costs here. You can exchange the cheque for cash (euros) at a bank. Please note that this amount must last until your next appointment at the social welfare office (approx. 1 month). You will not get any more money until your next appointment at the Social Welfare Office.

The Social Welfare Office is also your point of contact for the following topics:

- Vouchers for baby products and for your child's school supplies
- Money for train tickets to interview appointments
- Medical certificates, approval for operations and other medical procedures
- Educational and participation package (BuT)
- · Refugee integration activities
- Activities and employment programme
- Applications for relocation, waiving of the residence requirement

Public Health Department (Gesundheitsamt)

The Public Health Department forms part of Germany's healthcare system. One of its jobs, for example, is to protect the public from infectious diseases. And to promote good hygiene in organisations. These can be hospitals and care providers. Or restaurants and cafés. Would you like to work in a restaurant? Then you will need to be trained in how to prevent infections. But the Public Health Department has other responsibilities too. It gives advice on AIDS. And it focuses on medical services. It visits schools to provide information about how to prevent diseases. And it informs the general public about health risks.

Alzey-Worms Health Department

The Health Department for the District of Alzey-Worms carries out **school admissions examinations** and **initial medical examinations upon admission**. The Health Department also helps in the case of mental health problems. The Health Department also provides various advisory services if you or your relatives are suffering from or have contracted infectious diseases. You can also access vaccination or AIDS advice at the Health Department. The Health Department is represented at two locations:

"Jugendamt" (Youth Welfare Office)

In Germany, children's rights (the best interests of the child) must be observed when raising children and young people. You can find out more about this in the chapter entitled "Living together in Germany". The Youth Welfare Office (Jugendamt) supports parents in raising children and youth. Anyone can contact the Youth Welfare Office (Jugendamt) free of charge, including children and teenagers, if they have problems.

Responsibilities of the Youth Welfare Office (Jugendamt):

- · Supporting young people in their individual development and social development
- · Providing advice and support to parents with questions regarding raising children
- Protecting children and young people





- Contributing to positive living conditions for young people and families
- · Eliminating and reducing disadvantages
- When your child is born, the Youth Welfare Office (Jugendamt) will contact you after a few
 weeks in order to make a home visit and introduce themselves. Then you will receive a
 whole folder with information and services for your child and your family.

 \mathbb{Q} Unaccompanied minor refugees also fall under the Youth Welfare Law (SGB VIII) and are therefore the responsibility of the Youth Welfare Office.

Job Centre Alzey-Worms

Are you unemployed? Do you need help? The Job Centre provides financial support. It also helps you find work and get qualifications. That depends on your individual needs. The Job Centre makes it possible for you to take a language course, for example. It can help you get career guidance. Or it can help you get recognition for your educational qualifications. Would you like to work? Then you can find information and get advice here: Access to the Job Market.

 \bigcirc The Job Centre staff are not allowed to pass on information about clients. Do you have a volunteer accompanying you? Then you need to give them power of attorney. This must be completed in full and signed by both parties.

Solution loss still ongoing? Or has your application been rejected? Then the employment agency is responsible for answering questions pertaining to employment support.


Steps to take after a positive decision

The Federal Office for Migration and Refugees (BAMF) has given you a positive decision. That means your asylum application has been successful. You are recognised as entitled to asylum. Or you have been granted protection as a refugee. Here are the next steps you need to take:

1. Personal visit

- You must go to the Jobcenter during opening hours
- · You will be registered as a client there
- · Your background will be registered





- A consultation appointment will be made with the "Leistungsabteilung" (benefits department) An appointment will be made with the "Arbeitsvermittlung" (employment service)
- You will be registered as a jobseeker

2. Benefits department

Important: There is no consultation without an appointment.

• You can apply for benefits. To do this, you need an appointment. The person responsible for you can help with this.

3. Employment agency

- **Important:** There is no consultation without an appointment.
- Have you already attended an integration course? Bring your certificate with you.
 Otherwise, bring your "Verpflichtung" (obligation statement) with you.
- Do you have documents about school attendance or training? Do you have work references? Have your foreign qualifications been recognised? Bring them with you.
- Tell us about the special skills you possess (your trade, language skills etc.).
- · Before the appointment, think about which area of work you are interested in.

Agentur für Arbeit (Employment Agency)


The Employment Agency (Agentur für Arbeit) is your most important point of contact regarding employment. If you are looking for a job or for help choosing a career in Germany, or need your qualifications recognised, etc., you should contact the Employment Agency (Agentur für Arbeit).

If your asylum procedure is still under way (Aufenthaltsgestattung) or if you have exception leave to remain (Duldung), then the Employment Agency is your contact for questions about the transition from school to work (career advice), job placements and advice on further vocational training and employer advice (Arbeitgeber-Service).

Have you been recognised? Then the <u>Job Centre</u> is your point of contact for counselling and job placements.

Immigration Office (Registration Office/Registry Office) / Ausländerbehörde (Einwohneramt/Einwohnermeldeamt)

To be able to live in Germany as an immigrant, you will need a residence title (visa, residence permit, EU Blue Card, settlement permit, permanent residence permit). To apply for a residence title, the first thing you need to do is visit the Immigration Office (Ausländerbehörde) in the District of Alzey-Worms.

Other tasks of the Immigration Office:

- · Renew an arrival certificate
- Get or renew a temporary residence permit (Aufenthaltsgestattung)
- · Apply for a work permit
- · Registration certificate, registering and de-registering from a place of residence
- Residence permit (Aufenthaltserlaubnis) and special permits for travel

Steps after a positive decision from the BAMF

Apply for an electronic residence permit (eAT)

(1) Application for asylum

You can apply online. To do so, use the "Online application". Alternatively, you can fill out the "Residence permit application" form. Then send the form by post to the Immigration Office. The form can be downloaded online. Or you can collect it at the information desk in the Immigration Office. Please bring an interpreter with you when making your application. He or she can translate for you (to explain the reason for your visit).

(2) Appointment

As soon as the form has been received and processed by the Immigration Office (Ausländerbehörde), you will be sent a letter with date for an appointment as well as a list of all required documents


 \mathbb{Q} Important: Ask for a probationary permit (Fiktionsbescheinigung) to be issued as a temporary replacement document (required for the Job Centre).

(3) Collection

You will receive a letter informing you that you can pick up your new permit

Standesamt (Registry Office)

The Standesamt (Registry Office) has several responsibilities. For example, if a child is born, the parents are required to report the birth of the child to the Registry Office (certification of birth). If you want to get married, the registry office is responsible for registering your marriage.

The tasks of the Registry Office at a glance

- · Certifying births and deaths
- · Marriages and life partnerships
- Accepting applications to leave the Church
- Name changes
- Issuing documents (birth certificate, death certificate, marriage certificate)

You will always find the relevant registry office in the district or local authority which serves the area in which you live.

General information on consultations

In addition to the district administration of Alzey Worms, we have various offices in the District of Alzey Worms that can assist you with questions about residence and asylum law, provide support with administrative matters and the use of educational and language support services. You will receive individual counselling. In addition, we have many volunteers throughout the district who can help you find your way around at a faster rate. Volunteers are citizens who do not work on behalf of an authority or institution and therefore do not receive any money for the work that they do. Volunteering is very important in Germany, and becoming a volunteer yourself is also a good way of integrating into your community.

Advisory Committee for Migration and Integration





The Committee for Migration and Integration is responsible for promoting and ensuring that community members from different cultural backgrounds and of different nationalities and religions are treated as equals. The committee voices the concerns of immigrants living in the District of Alzey Worms and represents them before the district assembly, the district administration and the general public. The Advisory Committee for Migration and Integration can have a say in municipal policy decisions which affect migration and integration, carry out projects and influence these decisions. As such, it acts as an important facilitator for immigrants which allows them to participate in politics and social life.

Services: The Advisory Committee for Migration and Integration promotes dialogue between cultures at numerous events to which all migrant organisations from our district and the district's integration office are always invited. Information events on various topics are also offered on an ongoing basis.

Weißer Ring e.V. Help for victims of crime and violence

The WEISSER RING is Germany's largest aid organisation for victims of crime and violence. In the District of Alzey-Worms, the association maintains a branch office with professionally trained volunteer victim helpers who provide support to victims of crime who are in need of assistance through no fault of their own. They listen, offer comfort and provide individual care for those affected. For example, they accompany victims to the police station or to court proceedings. If necessary, they will arrange an initial consultation with a lawyer or trauma specialist or a forensic medical examination.

In individual cases, the association also provides financial assistance for reconciling crime-related emergencies.

Tasks of the Integration Officer


The Integration Officer is employed by the district administration of Alzey-Worms. They work on concepts and projects to support the integration of immigrants, migrants and refugees.

Integration in the District of Alzey-Worms means diversity above all else! This reflects the diversity of cultures and the diversity of lifestyles that we encounter in the District of Alzey-Worms. The work done by the Integration Officer is based on the contents of the Rhineland-Palatinate's guiding principles for integration and is seen as a task for society as a whole. Full-time providers and advisory centres in the District of Alzey Worms

Asylum seekers living in the district who have been assigned to us by the state of Rhineland-Palatinate will receive benefits for their living expenses from the social services department in accordance with the Asylum Seekers Benefits Act (AsylbLG). These include the necessary benefits for food, clothing, shoes, health care and consumer goods.

Passport procurement costs and journeys to the embassy or hearing costs as part of the asylum seeking process can be covered to the amount of the cost of a "Rhineland-Palatinate ticket" upon presentation of the summons and tickets.


You must declare income from employment, receipt of child benefits, other cash inflows or assets when receiving benefits in accordance with the Asylum Seekers' Benefits Act (Asylbewerberleistungsgesetz),. Unjustified benefits will be reclaimed if you fail to declare this.

Asylum seekers will receive higher monthly benefits in accordance with § 2 AsylbLG after 15 months of residence in Germany. These are based on the benefits set out in SGB XII.

Refugee integration measures:





So-called refugee integration measures were created in accordance with § 5a AsylbLG as a means of making the lives of asylum seekers easier while they wait for the asylum process to be completed.

Similar to the previous measures (being called upon to do community service according to § 5 AsylbLG), asylum seekers are given the opportunity to work for non-profit organisations (municipalities, churches, charities...). This can be help to maintain public green spaces, etc. In such cases, the asylum seeker will receive an additional expense allowance of € 0.80 per hour, in addition to the usual social benefits in accordance with the AsylbLG, to ensure that they can meet the costs of living.

Emergency health care: According to § 4 AsylbLG, persons entitled to benefits shall receive health assistance, i.e. the assumption of medical treatment and medication costs. In contrast to persons with statutory health insurance, health assistance under the AsylbLG only covers treatment for acute illnesses and pain. Furthermore, costs for necessary medical check-ups and vaccinations can be covered. Every quarter, the Social Welfare Department will issue the necessary health insurance certificates upon request. These can also be requested by e-mail or by telephone from the responsible clerks.

If asylum seekers receive benefits in accordance with § 2 AsylbLG (analogous to SGB XII) after 15 months of residence in Germany, they will be registered with a statutory health insurance of their choice by the Social Welfare Office. All health expenses will continue to be borne by the social welfare office in accordance with the AsylbLG. However, they are then entitled to the usual health insurance benefits provided by the statutory health insurance provider.
