Waste separation

Blue bin - waste paper

This belongs in it:

- Newspapers and magazines
- Books and catalogues
- Paper packaging and cardboard boxes
- Boxes and cartons

Coated boxes belong in the yellow bin.

Green bin - organic waste, compostable waste

This belongs in it:

- Fruit and vegetable waste
- Food waste
- Coffee filters and egg shells
- Flowers and garden waste

Black / grey bin - residual waste

This belongs in it:

- Hoover bags, rubbish, cigarette butts
- Hygiene articles (nappies, sanitary towels, cotton buds, cosmetic tissues, used paper tissues)
- Broken pieces of porcelain, ceramics and glass
- Light bulbs (Important! No fluorescent tubes or energy-saving bulbs)
- Wallpaper remnants and covering material from renovations
- Ashes (Important! Only cooled down)
- Photo paper
- Empty file folders
- Dried out remnants of wall paint

Yellow bin / Yellow bag - sales packaging

This belongs in it:





Sales packaging made of plastic, aluminium, tinplate and composite materials such as tetra packs

- Tin cans
- Plastic cups and bottles
- Beverage packaging
- Styrofoam packaging
- Plastic and aluminium foil from the household (no tarpaulins)
- Disposable crockery
- Plastic bags

Bulky waste - things too big for the residual waste bin

This belongs in bulky waste:

- Wood cupboards, tables, chairs, bed frames, chests of drawers, ...
- Electrical appliances televisions, washing machines, refrigerators, ...
- Other bulky waste armchairs, mattresses, carpets, prams, "Bobby-Car", ...

Please place the bulky waste separately in front of the house. Put wood next to wood and electrical appliances next to electrical appliances. The bulky waste is collected by different refuse lorries.

This does not belong in bulky waste:

- Small parts such as screws, nails and other small parts in bags or cardboard boxes in the residual waste bin or the waste management centre
- Glass and mirrors in the residual waste bin or the waste management centre
- Washbasins and toilet bowls to the waste management centre or recycling centre (construction waste).
- Wood from outdoor areas to the waste management centre if it has been treated with wood preservatives.
- Material containing asbestos and mineral wool to the waste management centre, please contact the district's waste advisory service.
- Construction site waste to the waste management centre

Pollutant mobile - pollutants

This belongs to the hazardous waste mobile:

- Residual quantities of e.g. cleaning agents, adhesives or batteries
- Solvents,
- paints, varnishes





- Products labelled as hazardous substances

Twice a year, in spring and autumn, the hazardous waste mobile comes to every municipality and town in the district of Giessen.

It is available every Saturday from 09:00 - 12:00 at the Waste Management Centre (AWZ) in Giessen, Lahnstraße 220, for tradespeople on the 1st Wednesday from 09:00 - 11:00 each month and on the 1st Friday of each month from 15:00 - 17:00 in Laubach on the fairground "Auf der Helle".

Fire protection

Smoke alarms save lives

Smoke detectors are located in various places on the ceiling of houses and flats. In the event of a fire, a loud, shrill alarm sounds. We need this acoustic signal, especially to be protected while we sleep. This is how the smoke alarm can become a lifesaver. Because the most dangerous thing in a fire is not the fire, but the toxic smoke. Smoke alarms do not prevent fires, but they do detect smoke and warn you in good time with a loud signal. Please make sure that smoke alarms are present and report any abnormalities such as absence, sounds or light signals to your landlord or landlady immediately.

Behaviour in emergencies

Whether in the event of a fire or accident, you can call **112** for help quickly in an emergency. Please provide the following information:

Who is reporting?
What has happened?
How many people are affected/injured?
Where has something happened?
Wait for further enquiries!

In the event of a fire, please get yourself and your relatives to safety. The lift must not be used if there is a fire in the building. Always follow the instructions of the police and emergency services.







Mobility

Using public transport facilities such as a bus or a train, many points of interest in Landkreis Gießen and environment can be reached easily. A healthy, cheap and ecologically clean alternative to go from point A to point B is a bicycle.

Public transport

General information

In Germany, public transport facilities such as trains or buses (underground railways, trams etc. in big cities) are available to people. You just need a valid ticket.

Bus

In Gießen, mainly bus lines are provided for public transport. The towns and villages of Landkreis Gießen are provided with trains, buses, AST and ALT.

ALT and AST public transport

If it's not profitable to make a tour with a big bus, e. g. if only a low number of people use it, an ALT or AST will be sent. ALT is an abbreviation for Anruf-Linien-Taxi (call line taxi), AST stands for Anruf-Sammel-Taxi (call collective taxi). This is usually a minibus or a passenger car. Despite the word "taxi" in the name, ALT and AST shouldn't be confused with a "normal" taxi. The word "Taxi" refers only to the appearance and the holder of the vehicle. ALT and AST circulate as line traffic and are thus subjected to the rules of line traffic. This means: The time table is applicable, entry only at official stops and tickets as well as rates as applicable to buses.

The principle behind ALT and AST is the same: You can use it only, when the tour has been registered correctly in advance. The phone for registering is given on the relevant time table. Registering is correct only, if realized at least 60 minutes in advance. The exact





number of passengers stated when registering is binding. ALT and AST can transport a maximum of 8 passengers. If a tour is already full, another tour must be chosen.

ALT and AST have a fixed time table. Only stops for which a tour has been registered are served. Deviations from the time table aren't possible. The ALT/AST will always go directly from the start to the destination stop.

Tours within a single locality aren't possible with ALT or AST.

When chosing an AST, you have to pay an additional charge of 1.50 EUR and you get out at a place of your choice at the destination, e. g. in front of your own door.

Train

There are various railway lines in Landkreis Gießen. Changing lines is possible at the Gießen main railway station, where trains going to the following directions can be chosen:

- Butzbach Bad Nauheim Friedberg Frankfurt
- Lollar Marburg Kirchhain Stadtallendorf Treysa Kassel
- Buseck Reiskirchen Grünberg Alsfeld Lauterbach Fulda
- Wetzlar Herborn Siegen

- Lich Hungen Nidda Gelnhausen

Changing to numerous bus lines is also possible at the main railway station.

Moreover, the Gießen railway station offers connection to long-distance IC and ICE DB routes (Binz -) Stralsund/Westerland - Hamburg - Hanover - Gießen - Frankfurt (M) - Karlsruhe/Würzburg - Oberstdorf/Munich - Berchtesgaden (white trains with red stripes)

Time tables and additional information

The time tables and departure times are hung out at all bus and train stops.

In the city of Gießen, there are also stops with real-time display of the next bus departure.

When checking time tables, make sure to note any restrictions. For example, many tours take place only on school days or during holidays. For holidays, see the website of Hessisches Kultusministerium: https://kultusministerium.hessen.de/schulsystem/f....

Moreover, you can check the footnotes and hints to find out if a tour is served by a regular bus or offered as a registration tour (see explanation for "ALT and AST").

All timetables are included in the connection information of Rhein-Main-Verkehrsverbund and Deutsche Bahn, which is available also in English, French, Spanish, Turkish and Italian. Tickets

To use a bus or a train, you always need to buy a valid ticket and present it, if there is a ticket inspection. In Landkreis Gießen and in the city of Gießen, the rates of RMV Rhein-Main-Verkehrsverbund www.rmv.de are applicable.

The price is not negotiable and must be paid by all passengers (special regulations are applicable only to seriously handicapped persons or e.g. police officers wearing a uniform).

For a tour from start to destination, you always need only one RMV ticket, no matter how often you change trains. Even if you change e. g. from bus or ALT to train.

Tickets must always be bought PRIOR TO starting a tour. No tickets may be bought at the train.

Tickets are available here:

Transport of children under the age of 6 accompanied by an adult is free, however, the adult person needs a valid ticket. Children and young people between the age of 6 and 14 can buy tickets at a lower rate. All persons from 15 years must buy an adult ticket. Pupils, trainees and senior people can buy less expensive tickets, however, they need a special document (e. g. school certificate or proof of age).

There are various types of tickets for all sorts of requirements:

- · Single-tour tickets
- Day tickets which make sense buying already for a return journey on the same day (also available for groups up to 5 persons)
- Weekly tickets
- · Monthly tickets
- · Annual tickets

RMV tickets are NOT valid at Deutsche Bahn IC and ICE trains (white trains with red stripes).

CAUTION

Using a bus or train without a valid ticket is not permitted. Persons who can't present a valid ticket when checking will have to pay an increased transport charge of **60 EUR**.

Bicycle

If you know that you will live in Landkreis Gießen during a longer period of time, it is a good idea to get a bicycle. This is cheaper than using a bus or a train.

Important traffic rules for cyclists (choice)

- · Always drive on the right side of the lane.
- Go behind each other rather than side by side.
- If a cycle track is provided, you must use it (always on the right of the street in driving direction).
- Only children up to the age of 11 are allowed to use the foot walks with a bicycle.
- Using a mobile phone when driving a bicycle is prohibited.





Purchasing and repairs

When buying a bicycle, make sure your bicycle is fitted with the following equipment and thus safe. Otherwise, you will have to pay a penalty, if you are stopped and checked by the police.

- · Font and rear lamp
- · Front and rear reflector
- Reflectors in the spokes (2 in each wheel)
- · Reflectors on the pedals
- Bell
- Two independent brakes

Liability insurance

If you harm someone in Germany without intention, you must pay compensation. This applies to injuries to people, damage to property and loss of money in private life.

Example: If you cause an accident with your car or your child breaks a window with a ball.

In Germany, you can take out private liability insurance to pay for these damages for you and your family. You can decide whether you want to take out this insurance. However, it is recommended.

Giro account

A giro account is an account for persons who want to make payments via a bank. Your money is always available on your giro account.

Using a giro account, you can:

Transfer money





- Receive cashless payments (payments from official authorities (social benefits). These are often transferred to a personal giro account.
- Set up standing orders
- · Make payments by direct debit
- · Pay in checks and make cashless payments using EC/Maestro card
- · Withdraw cash money at a bank counter or a cashpoint
- Print your account statements

Important: Make sure that there is enough money on your account for all withdrawals and payments.

Tip: Various banks offer giro accounts at varying conditions. Make sure to be informed how much money a giro account costs monthly and which services the bank offers for this money.

Opening an account

Decide at which bank you want to open an account. Make an appointment for opening the account. Please, bring one of your identity documents: Proof of arrival, residence authorization, identity document. If no current address is given on your identity document, please, bring an additional registration certificate or a comparable document.

Important: If you don't speak German or English, please, bring an interpreter.

Important notes:

- After opening an account, you will get an EC card with a four-digit PIN code. Sign the EC card
 on the rear and learn the PIN code by heart. The PIN code is required to make cashless
 payments and money withdrawals at a cashpoint. Keeping the card and the PIN code
 separately is indispensable!
- If you want to withdraw cash money, you should use a cashpoint belonging to the bank where
 you have your account. In this case, withdrawal is free of charge. If you enter three
 successive faulty PIN codes at a cashpoint, the EC card will be withdrawn and locked. In this
 case, you have to ask your bank.
- If your EC card is lost or stolen, you should have your EC card locked immediately. Give them your IBAN. Ask your bank to issue a new EC card.

Contracts and mobile phone





Particularly important: Don't ever sign a document which you didn't understand or can't read. Otherwise, you might sign a contract or an agreement implying an obligation to pay. It is sometimes quite difficult to cancel such a document. Always check several offers and take your time to make a decision. Don't let anybody urge you to sign a document.

In Germany, there are two types of contracts for mobile phones: Prepaid contracts and term contracts. A prepaid contract is without a fixed term. A term contract has a minimum contract term. This contract will be renewed automatically, unless you cancel it. If you don't want to renew the contract automatically, you must cancel it in writing. Make sure to be informed on the term.

10 important questions before making a contract:

- What is the basic charge? Will the charge increase after a defined period of time?
- Is there a monthly minimum charge (minimum costs per month)?
- What is the contract duration (e.g. 12 or 24 months)?
- · Will the contract be renewed automatically unless I cancel it?
- On which date will I have to cancel, if I don't want to renew the contract?
- How much money will be charged for setting up, changing and de-activating?
- Which is the timing cycle (60/1, 10/10) used for calculation?
- What is the cost per minute (third-party/own network)?
- What is the cost of a mobile with contract and how much money does the mobile cost without a contract?
- · How much does Internet cost?
- How expensive are calls to a foreign country?

Apartment hunting

Before you look for an apartment, make sure to be clear about what exactly you should look for (own apartment, room at a shared apartment), how expensive the rent may be (for upper limits of rental charges, see also rental charges/rental contract) and which requirements should be met by the apartment (size, situation, accessible to disabled persons, etc.).

If you get money from the state for you and your family, you don't normally need to file an application for payment of a housing allowance.
