Access to the employment market

Regulations on access to the employment market

If you are a job seeker and immigrant from an EU country, you enjoy freedom of employment and unlimited access to the employment market. For refugees, accessibility is different depending on residence status. For explanations, see below. Below you can find more options for counselling centers.

Asylum seekers with proof of arrival or permission to stay:

A long as you have to live at an initial accommodation facility, you are not allowed to work. Later on, the »»Ausländerbehörde will decide, if you may work. For this reason, first thing to do is to file an application to grant an authorization to work with Ausländerbehörde.

The following prerequisites are important for the decision on an authorization to work:

- Three months after your registration as an asylum seeker in Germany (with proof of arrival or permission to stay), you have "lower ranking" access to the employment market. This means that Bundesagentur für Arbeit will check, if there is a privileged applicant for the employment. Moreover, the employment conditions are checked.
- After 15 months, no ranking check will take place any more. However, the work conditions will still be checked.
- After 48 months, you have full access to the employment market. No restrictions are applicable any more. However, you must file a corresponding application and have it recorded in your permission to stay.
- If a company-based training is concerned, the decision on the work permit is made exclusively by Ausländerbehörde. No ranking check or check of work conditions by Bundesagentur für Arbeit will take place.

Persons with status "temporary suspension of deportation":

- If a person's status is "temporary suspension of deportation", the decision on the work permit is always made by the Ausländerbehörde. The Ausländerbehörde can impose a general ban on employment for foreigners.
- Unless such a ban has been imposed on you, you have lower-ranking access to the employment market from the first day of status "temporary suspension of deportation".
- Otherwise, the prerequisites for access to the employment market are as described above.

Refugees with residence permit:

When you have been recognized by Bundesamt für Migration und Flüchtlinge (BAMF) as an asylum seeker, refugee or person eligible to subsidiary protection, the Ausländerbehörde will grant you a work permit. This permit entitles you to exercise an employment and gives you full access to the employment market.

Different rules apply to free-lance professional activity!

Prerequisite for the above-mentioned applications is ALWAYS a specific employment offer.

Job turbo

Job-Turbo: Support for refugees

There is a job turbo to get people into work more quickly. It helps employers and refugees to find each other more easily.

Why is the Job Turbo important?

- Many refugees want to live and work in Germany.
- They need a chance to find a job or an apprenticeship.

How does the Job Turbo work?

Phase 1: Orientation and learning German

- Refugees learn German.
- They receive help with orientation in Germany.

Phase 2: Work and qualification

- Refugees work and gain qualifications.
- They learn new skills and knowledge.

Phase 3: Stabilisation and expansion of work

- Refugees have a permanent job.
- They can expand their work and take advantage of new opportunities.

Opportunities for companies:

- In cooperation with the employment agency, companies find new employees.
- Help in the search for suitable employees.

Target group:

Refugees who have already completed an integration course. Or will soon complete one.

Employer service

- The [Employment Agency](#) lists vacant jobs and apprenticeships. Vacant jobs and apprenticeships are compiled by the Employment Agency.
- The Employment Agency advises companies on how they can reach and employ refugees.
- The Employment Agency offers financial support.
- Applicant days and speed dating events are organised.

Education and training (dual system and full-time school)

In Germany, it is of great advantage, if you have a **professional qualification** before you start working. On average, persons who have a professional qualification earn more money, are less frequently unemployed and have less frequently temporary employment contracts than people seeking a job without a professional qualification.

Dual training

A particularity in Germany is dual training. One third of dual training takes place at a »»Vocational school, whereas two thirds of the training occur at a training company. In this way, you are familiarized simultaneously with theory and practice and will earn money already during training at a company.

Depending on what kind of profession you want to learn during dual training, you have to contact a suitable center:

Handwerkskammer (Chamber of Crafts)

Handwerkskammer (HWK) is the competent body for handicrafts. If you want to train as a baker, mason or painter, you can get information from a Handwerkskammer.

Training at a vocational school

However, there is not only a dual training option in Germany, but also training at a technical school. A technical school provides completed theoretical and practical professional training outside the dual training system (without an employment as a trainee at a company). Training programs usually take two or three years. Lessons are attended full-time and normally comprise subjects of general interest apart from vocational subjects. As there are important differences as to the disciplines, conditions for admittance, training duration and further options for education at technical schools, we recommend seeking information from the relevant school.

Compulsory education at a vocational school:

The duty to attend a vocational school starts after completion of full-time school attendance (6 to 15 years of age) after leaving a full-time school and starting to work in a trainee relationship.

Trainees having a training position in the sense of the law on vocational training are subject to compulsory attendance of a vocational school for the duration of the training employment.

After completing the extended full-time compulsory school attendance, young people who don't have a trainee relationship are entitled to attend a vocational school during three years up to the end of the school year in which they complete the 18th year of their life.

Compulsory attendance of a vocational school is met by attending a vocational school at the school district in which the place of employment is situated. If a handicapped person is concerned, this is the place of the workshop.

For persons entitled to attend a vocational school without a trainee relationship, the place of residence is decisive, and, for persons entitled to attend a vocational school in measures of Bundesagentur für Arbeit, the place of the measure is decisive.

Funding and scholarship

As a student in Germany, you can apply for financial support pursuant to Bundesausbildungsförderungsgesetz (in short: BAföG). BAföG funding is paid per month and maximally for the duration of the studies. The BAföG amount per month can be between 399 and 735 euros. Half of the BAföG amount must be refunded after the studies. The exact information on BaföG changes regularly and can be displayed via the following link:

An alternative to BAföG is a scholarship. Unlike BAföG, there is normally no need to refund a scholarship. But good achievements and unpaid commitment play a decisive part for granting a scholarship. The amount is often calculated analogously to the BAföG amount. Additionally, there is a so-called "Allowance for books", which is a monthly payment of up to 300 €.

Organizations granting scholarships are often called organizations for promotion of talented students. The following organizations offer programs especially for refugees. For application guidelines and requirements, see the relevant websites.

Kiron Higher Education

It is sometimes difficult for people from other countries to get into a university. At **Kiron Higher Education** , you can study without paying tuition fees. You also don't need the legal

documents to study there. Study places are also not limited. The first two years of the degree programme take place as online courses via the internet. All courses are offered in English. It is possible to add subtitles in any language. The third year of the programme takes place at one of Kiron's partner universities. Recognition of reports and certificates

Recognition of foreign educational qualifications

Reports, certificates and **testimonials** play an important part at school, university or during professional career in Germany. They provide evidence of what you have already learned and achieved. They are a decisive prerequisite to get an employment or to be admitted to a school or a university. When you have already acquired certificates at school, during training or at university in a foreign country, you should apply for **recognition** of these certificates in Germany. This means your qualification to exercise a job in Germany is checked based on your certificates and your achievements are translated. Perhaps you have lost your certificates. In this case, you can try to have your professional experience and skills recognized by tests.

When you seek studies or an employment as a scientist, you can contact the relevant persons at university for recognition of your certificates.

Official authentication of certificates

An official authentication is a confirmation of the authenticity of a document. For example, you need it to register at a university. The copies of the certificates must be authenticated officially.

What an authentication must contain

- An authentication note saying that the copy corresponds to the original script
- The original stamp of the authenticating body
- The original signature of the authenticating person
- You are not allowed to send a copy of the authenticated document!

Who is allowed to authenticate a document?

Official authentications can be provided by any official body having an official seal. For example, these are official authorities (municipal and district administrations) as well as notaries.

Please note that not all municipal administrations authenticate certificate copies in foreign languages. You should inform yourself in advance, if your municipal administration provides authentication of these copies.

The following persons and centers are not authorized to provide authentication of copies: Translators, lawyers, public accountants, associations.

Can I have documents authenticated in a foreign country?

Yes, this service can be provided by a notary or an authority allowed to do so. In case of doubt, we will ask you to have the copies authenticated additionally in Germany.
