Until 30 September, you can still get vaccinated at the KIZ on Fridays to Wednesdays (08.00 to 18.00) and Thursdays (08.00 to 20.30) without making an appointment.

<u>From October onwards</u>, please <u>contact</u> your <u>family doctor</u>, <u>general practitioner</u> or <u>company doctor</u> for vaccinations. This also applies to second vaccinations. **Important**: Please observe the minimum interval between the first and second vaccination. The vaccination appointment must be arranged with the doctor's practice at least two weeks before the vaccination is due.

If you do not have a GP practice, you can find the location of the nearest Corona specialist practice on the <u>website of the Kassenärztliche Vereinigung BW</u> via the Corona map Baden-Württemberg.

Existing (second) vaccination appointments at the district vaccination centre <u>after 30</u> <u>September</u> are <u>invalid</u>, even if you receive an e-mail reminder.

The current 7-day incidence in the district of Heidenheim is over 200.

Therefore, the following applies to breaking the fast:

- A household is allowed to meet with one other person who is not part of their own household. Children under 14 are not counted.
- Ritual prayer: if the prayer is organised by an Islamic community, it is a religious event. Appropriate hygiene measures must be taken and guaranteed by the organiser.
