
Language courses offered on the basis of the "VwV Deutsch"

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In particular, refugees, but also other people with a migration background within the meaning of § 4 paragraph 1 PartIntG BW who want to learn the German language or improve their existing German language skills, can take part in the language courses, provided that they do not have access to the language courses of the Federal Office for Migration and Refugees (BAMF) or do not yet have access to them. Children, adolescents and young adults who attend a school are not eligible to participate, nor are persons who are obliged to attend an integration course of the BAMF. Persons who come from a safe country of origin as tolerated persons are only eligible to participate if their termination of residence for reasons for which they are not responsible is not expected until further notice. The programme is intended to offer the above-mentioned target group free access to the acquisition of the German language and thus enable them to integrate into society.

In addition to literacy, basic and advanced courses, the district of Ludwigburg also offers specific course formats such as parent and women's language courses in smaller groups with childcare or intensive language courses before the start of training. In addition, low-threshold language offers in the form of language cafés or language meetings are offered in the district municipalities within the framework of the VwV German.
