An application for guardianship must be made in writing. The guardian represents the minor child as an additional legal representative in establishing paternity and/or in maintenance matters. If necessary, the guardian also represents the child in court. This does not restrict parental custody.

Requirements: underage child with habitual residence in Germany; the parent making the application lives in the city of Munich
