Counselling and help / Separation - Divorce

Apply for maintenance advance

Maintenance advance centres of the municipal youth welfare office

Are you bringing up your child alone? Then the other parent must pay money for the child. This money is called maintenance.


Can the other parent not pay maintenance? Can the other parent not pay maintenance every month? Does the other parent not want to pay maintenance?

Then you can apply for advance maintenance payments. This means that the youth welfare office pays the maintenance.

The other parent must later repay the advance maintenance payment to the Youth Welfare Office.

The law on advance maintenance payments states who is entitled to advance maintenance payments. The short word for the Maintenance Advance Act is: UVG.

The UVG contains many rules for advance maintenance payments. The youth welfare office can advise you. They will help you with your application.

The amount of money is calculated according to the  [Düsseldorf table](#).

Who is it for: Children up to the age of 18 if they or the parent looking after them have German citizenship or the right to freedom of movement (EU/EEA citizenship), a settlement permit or residence permit (authorisation to work; permanent residence).
