Community centres

There are 12 social community centres in Munich. We support all adults, young people and children. For example, we help with these emergency situations:

- We help if you can't pay your rent.
- · We help if you have debts.
- · We help if you have a disability and need support.
- We help if you have problems in your family.
- We help if you don't have a job.
- We help if you are ill and have problems.
- · We help if you are old and have problems.
- We help if you are desperate and don't know what to do next.

This is how we help you:

- We inform and advise you.
- We support you and show you where you can get help.
- · We take care of your protection in the event of violence, endangerment and neglect.
- If you wish, we can also come to your home.

Our help is open to all people, regardless of gender, cultural or social background, age, religion, ideology, disability and sexual or gender identity.

The service is free of charge.

All community centres have a barrier-free entrance.

It is possible to do the counselling with the help of interpreters.

Children can be brought along.

Help with social / financial hardship

Help with social / financial hardship

Everyone has the right to get help. The Social Department helps people in Munich who are in need because they do not have enough money. Social Law Book 12 regulates what help is available and who can receive it. The abbreviation is SGB 12 or SGB XII.

To receive social assistance, you must submit an application. They will then check how much money, income or assets you have. Once everything has been calculated, you will receive a letter. It will tell you how much money you will receive and how it was calculated. The money will help you to pay for things like food, toiletries, clothing, furniture, education, health insurance, electricity or housing.

Who does not receive social assistance?

- · If you have too much money.
- If you can work but don't have a job at the moment or earn too little. Then the job centre is responsible for you.
- If you don't have a flat. Then the homelessness assistance centre can help.

Who gets social welfare?

- · You can no longer work because you are too old or ill.
- You can no longer pay your rent.
- · You don't have enough money for food.

How much money can I get?

That depends on your situation. For example, your age or whether you live alone or with a family. Some people need more than others, for example because they are pregnant or ill. The amount of money you need is calculated individually.

Where can I apply?

At a <u>social welfare centre (SBH)</u>.

What documents do I need?

- Your identity card
- Your severely disabled person's ID card, if you have one



- Your tenancy agreement and, if you have one, the letter stating when your rent was last increased
- Documents about your income, e.g. payslip, pension statement
- Documents about your assets, such as savings balances, car documents, building society savings contracts, life insurance policies, house ownership, property ownership
- Bank statements from the last 3 months
- Documents showing whether you need care, for example a written notification from the care insurance fund

Debt counselling

Debt counselling

We advise people who have debts. The counselling is confidential. This means that we are not allowed to tell anyone about the counselling session. We cannot give you money or loans. But we can help you:

- · negotiate with creditors
- · in reviewing the claims that exist against you
- · in the preparation and implementation of insolvency proceedings
- with budget planning
- in arranging household support
- · in the event of seizure measures by creditors

Only with your reliable, honest and active co-operation can we support you in resolving your debt situation.

This service is free of charge.

(If you let us know in advance, we can organise a person who can translate. This will not incur any costs for you.
