Office for Training Assistance

Everyone in Germany should have the opportunity to complete vocational training or a secondary school qualification. Some parents are unable to support their children because they do not have enough money. There are two laws that provide financial support for training. They are called:



- "Bundesausbildungsförderungsgesetz (BAföG)"
- · "Aufstiegsfortbildungsförderungsgesetz (AFBG)"

The Office for Training Assistance will help you to apply.

Prerequisites:

BAföG As a rule, only those who are under 45 years of age at the start of their training can receive financial support. The funding also depends on the residence status and income of the parents or spouse.

AFBG can be applied for regardless of age. The income of relatives is also not taken into account here. However, a certain residence status is also required and only certain training courses are subsidised.



For whom:

- Pupils at secondary schools, for example specialised upper secondary schools, vocational upper secondary schools, vocational colleges, technical colleges, technical academies
- People who have completed vocational training and would like to complete further education or training. For example to "Meister".
- Students
- Pupils from Germany who are attending a training centre in Austria
