Important rules in the shared accommodation (GU)

Every house has rules.

All the rules are in the house rules.

You must observe the house rules and regulations.

Be quiet!

There are quiet times.

When do I have to be quiet?

Monday to Saturday: 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. and 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Sunday and all day on public holidays:

No loud music.

No noise...

You have to separate rubbish!
