You can do sport free of charge in the leisure sports hall.

You can go there without registering.

You can join in anywhere.

You can take your family and friends with you.

You can try out many different types of sport.

Sport in the park - free of charge

Sport in the Park is a sports programme for older people.

You can take part free of charge.

You can take part without registering.

You don't need any special sports clothing.

The programmes are offered in various parks in Regensburg.

The offer is available every year from 2 May to 31 October.

You can find current information and the programmehere.

Regensburg goes fit - free of charge

You do fitness in the open air.

You can do yoga, Zumba, functional training and energy dance.

The programme is available every summer from June to July.

When? Every Sunday from 4 pm to 7 pm.

Professional trainers are there for you.

Campus Asyl does sport - free of charge

You can do sport for free at Campus Asyl.

You can go without registering.

You can:

- Swim
- · Ride a bike
- dance
- play foot-ball
- · much more

Other outdoor sports - free of charge

You can also do sport on your own.

Or with friends.

Here you can see where you can do these types of sport:

Football, skating, curling, beach volleyball, fitness and boccia.

If you have children, you can go to playgrounds.

You can make friends on playgrounds.

There are lots of playgrounds in Regensburg.

There are many different ways to play.

Here you can see where the playgrounds are.

Playgrounds often also have football pitches and benches.

That's good.

So everyone has fun!

Jogging

You can jog anywhere in the city.

That's normal.

Pay attention to the traffic rules!

There are many important traffic rules in Germany.

You must observe these rules.

Other sports facilities

There are other sports halls and sports grounds in Regensburg.

These often belong to a **club**. Look under " Sports clubs".

You have to become a member of a club.

This usually costs money.

You can then do different types of sport.

Enquire at a club near you.

Search for a club for you here.

Women's integration through sport with fun

As a woman, you can join the FIT Regensburg project straight away.

These are low-cost sports programmes, especially for women with and without a migration background.

You can take part in Zumba, women's fitness, body shaping or progressive muscle relaxation. You can cycle for free.





The sports programmes sometimes include childcare.

Sometimes there is a play corner for children.

Fitness centres and course providers

You can also do sports very well outside of sports clubs.

You can go to fitness centres.

These programmes cost money.

You often have to sign a contract.

This means you have to pay for at least a year.

Read the contract carefully!

Search the internet for "fitness studio".

It doesn't cost much. It's free for children. There are favourable rates for asylum seekers, students, welfare recipients and other groups. You can also use many of the services free of charge without a membership.

Adult Education Centre Regensburg





The adult education centre (VHS) is a school where adults can attend courses. The courses are very diverse.

Courses are offered for learning languages, computer skills, sports, art and more.

Anyone who wants to can take part and the prices are usually favourable. The VHS helps people to learn new skills or further their education.

There are 845 adult education centres in Germany. A VHS often has several locations and there are almost 3000 centres in Germany.

The majority of courses and events at Regensburg Adult Education Centre take place in the Thon-Dittmer-Palais on Haidplatz, in Scheugässchen or in the Education Centres in KÖWE and Candis.
