Living in Rosenheim

You must read the **rental agreement** carefully. If you don't understand everything, ask a person you trust.

Re-register within the next two weeks after moving in.

You work and can pay your own rent:

You must pay the rent to the landlord on time every month. You pay for water, heating and electricity. If the rent is not paid regularly and rent debts arise, you risk termination without notice.

You have to pay a deposit once. This means you have to pay the landlord a sum of money once. The deposit is a security payment for the landlord in case something is broken in the accommodation owned by them. So you lend the money and get it back if you haven't broken anything.

They work but earn little money. Then you can apply for housing benefit.

What is "Wohngeld"?

Housing benefits are financial support. You can get money for your rent every month.

You must apply for housing benefit.

You submit the application to the social welfare office

You get money from the job centre and have found a flat.

Important: Show the Job Centre the new tenancy agreement before you sign it. The Job Centre must first check whether the costs for the accommodation are reasonable. If you have the OK from the Job Centre, then you can sign the tenancy agreement.

Also ask the Job Centre about a loan for the deposit.

Insurances

There are insurances that you must have.

For example: When you work, you automatically pay into 5 insurances. Health insurance, accident insurance, pension insurance, unemployment insurance and long-term care insurance. You pay one half of your contribution. The other half is paid by your employer. You don't have to do anything. The money for these insurances is automatically deducted from your gross income.

Compulsory social insurance

Health insurance

Health insurance is compulsory for everyone in Germany. Each person pays a certain amount of money per month into the health insurance scheme.

Family members who live in Germany can also be insured. The prerequisite for this is that they have no or only a low income. Children are co-insured as long as they attend school (up to the age of 25). You can choose between different health insurance companies.

Unemployment insurance

This insurance provides financial assistance in the event of unemployment. Anyone who is unemployed, has personally registered as unemployed or has paid into unemployment insurance for at least one year in the last two years is entitled to unemployment benefit.

Care insurance

Long-term care insurance covers you if you need care in old age. If you have any questions, call your health insurance company.

Pension insurance

Pension insurance is important for old-age provision. Whether you receive a pension depends on various things:

You have to reach a certain age. As a rule, people in Germany receive a pension from the age of 67. However, it is also possible to retire earlier or later.

You have to apply for a pension.

You must have paid into the pension insurance scheme for a certain period of time beforehand.

Voluntary insurance - examples

Liability insurance

Example: You are visiting your neighbour and accidentally sit on her glasses. The glasses are broken.

Example: You live in a rented flat. Your washing machine is leaking water. You don't notice it. Only after a few days do you notice the water stains on the floor. The floor under the washing machine is broken and needs to be replaced.

You can report this damage to your insurance company. This means you take a photo of the damage. Send this photo to your insurance company by e-mail. In your e-mail, you also explain why the damage has occurred. This e-mail to your insurance company is called a damage report.

The insurance company checks your damage report. If the damage is insured, the insurance company will pay part or all of the bill.

Important: You must not cause the damage on purpose. If you do, the insurance company will not cover the damage.

Household contents insurance pays for damage in your own household.

Example: Your house is burgled and the door is broken. You can then report this damage to your insurance company.

Disability insurance protects you against financial problems if you can no longer work.

Example: You have a serious accident and can therefore no longer work. You are unable to work.

Legal expenses insurance covers the costs of legal disputes in certain cases.

Important: Always get good advice when you take out insurance. And read all pages of the offer. Even the small print ;)

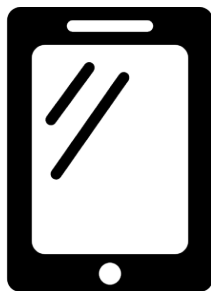

Mobile phones



Mobile phone with contract or prepaid mobile phone?

You can make a contract with a provider and then you pay money per month. If you decide to sign a contract, the contract is valid for 2 years and cannot be cancelled before then. Therefore, pay particular attention to the term of the contract and the notice periods.

The advantage of a prepaid mobile phone is that you do not have a contract period.

TV



In Germany, every household must pay broadcasting fees: GEZ fees. You will receive a bill, after which you send in the amount of money. If you receive social benefits such as money from the Job Centre, you can apply not to have to pay the GEZ fees.

On the road in Rosenheim



...with the bike

If you are staying here in Rosenheim for longer, it is worth buying your own bike. It is cheaper in the long run than taking the bus or train.

When buying a bicycle, check that it is **roadworthy**. Otherwise, you will have to pay a fine when subject to a police check.

A bicycle needs:

- Light front and rear
- Reflectors at the front and rear
- 2 reflectors per tyre at the front and rear
- Bell
- Two independent brakes

...by train

If you want to go to another city, e.g. Munich, Nuremberg, Augsburg...or to the BAMF, you can take the train.

You can buy a ticket at a machine at the railway station or ask an employee at the station.

Keep in mind that there are different train lines. Not every ticket allows you to take any train. ask if you are not sure!

On the train, you will be checked by a train attendant. If you have no ticket or the wrong kind, you will have to pay a €60 fine.



...with the city bus

There are many buses in Rosenheim. You can go almost anywhere with it.

You get on a bus at a bus stop. You can recognise a bus stop from the sign with a yellow-and-green "H".

You need to buy a bus ticket on the bus. You must always validate (stamp) the ticket. You do this on the bus at a vending machine. If you do not stamp your ticket, it is not valid for travel.

If you have no ticket, you will have to pay a €60 fine.

...by car or moped

Car driving licence (driving licence class B)

In order to be allowed to drive in Germany, you need a driving licence that is valid in Germany. Please contact the [driving licence authority of](#) the city of Rosenheim directly with your questions.

Moped licence (driving licence class A)

A moped goes max. 25 km/h. You also need a valid driving licence for this.
