

School and compulsory education

Children who are 6 years old by 30 September of the coming school year become compulsory schoolchildren and must attend a **primary school**. Grundschule attendance usually lasts 4 years. Depending on the area of the city in which you live, your child will be assigned a specific elementary school.

After attending primary school, schoolchildren transfer to a secondary school, Realschule or Gymnasium.

Young people who move in with a completed school education are subject to <u>compulsory</u> <u>vocational schooling</u>. Even if they have not yet found an apprenticeship.
