Integration Courses

You can learn German in an **integration course**. You will also learn a lot about German politics and society.

Who can attend an integration course?

- You are a migrant with a valid residence permit
- You are an asylum seeker with high prospects of staying (at the moment: Syria, Eritrea, Afghanistan, Somalia)
- You are an EU citizen and have a residence in Germany

The integration course has two parts: language course and orientation course.

1. Language course

The language course has 600 lesson units (hours). There are also integration courses with literacy. These types of courses have 900 lesson units for learning German. Before you attend the course, you do a placement test at the school, to make sure you start at the right level.

What do you learn in the language course? You will learn the vocabulary for all important areas of daily life. You learn how to write letters in German, how to fill in forms, and how to speak on the phone. The course finishes with a test called the "Deutschtest für Zuwanderer" (German Test for Immigrants).

2. Orientation course

The language course has 100 lesson units (hours).

What do you learn in the orientation course? They get to know Germany and learn important information about its laws and politics, culture and history. You will receive

information about your rights and obligations, but also about everyday life in Germany. The course finishes with this test: Life in Germany.

If you pass both tests, then you will receive the integration course certificate.

What does an integration course cost?

Now you can attend a **job-related language course** to get B2 or C1 level. This is important to be able to work successfully in the profession. Also for studies or training.
