Migration Office Rostock (Foreigners' Registration Office)

Would you like to live in Germany as a foreign national? Then you need a <u>residence permit</u> (Aufenthaltstitel). This can be a visa. Or a residence permit. You may also have a settlement permit or a permanent residence permit. Go to the Migration Office (Migrationsamt). You can apply for a residence permit there.

EU citizens do not have to register with the Migration Office. You can register directly at the <u>local</u> <u>offices</u>.

What else you can do at the Migration Office:

- Extend proof of arrival
- Issue and extend a residence permit
- Apply for a work permit
- Apply for a residence permit and special permits for travelling
- Naturalisation

&Steps after a positive decision from the BAMF

Apply for an electronic residence permit (eAT)

(1) Submitting the application

You can submit the application online. To do this, use the "Online application". You can also fill
out the "Application for a residence permit" form. You send this by post to the Migration Office.
You can download the form online. Please bring an interpreter with you when you submit your
application. They can translate your request (the reason for the visit).

(2) Appointment

- The form has been received by the Immigration Office. It has been processed. You will then receive an appointment by post. You will also receive a list of all the documents you need to bring with you
- Important: Have a fictitious certificate (Fiktionsbescheinigung) issued as a temporary replacement document. You will need this for the <u>job centre</u> (Jobcenter).

(3) Collection

• You will receive the collection notification by post
