☐ Kulturdolmetscher - simply explained
A cultural interpreter helps people who do not yet speak German well. They not only translate words, but also explain how things work in Germany. This helps to avoid misunderstandings.
☐ Who are Kulturdolmetscher?
 People with a history of migration who know both cultures They speak good German and another language They work on a voluntary basis, i.e. voluntarily and without pay (only a small expense allowance) They are not professional interpreters, but are well trained
☐ Where does Kulturdolmetscher help?
 At appointments in schools, nurseries or public authorities At the doctor or hospital At advice centres or when talking to the authorities
☐ How can I get help?
