Please register first in the town hall at the residents registration office (Einwohnermeldeamt) of the city or municipality in which you are staying. That is also necassary, if you got a current accommodation from family members or private contacts. At there, you will forwarded to the foreigners authority (Ausländerbehörde).

(Note: The city of Tübingen and Rottenburg has their own foreigners authority. For the city of Mössingen and for the municipalities of the district Tuebingen is the Foreign Authority of the Landratsamt Tübingen responsible.)

Local public transport

The district of Tübingen is committed to fast and well-developed public transport connections. The Local public transport (Öffentlicher Personennahverkehr - ÖPNV) plan adopted by the district council in 2012, which was updated in 2015, sets the goals and framework for the design of local public transport.

The main task of the Landratsamt is the planning of regional bus services, which connect the communities and cities in the district of Tübingen and neighboring districts. In addition to the routing and the timetable, the linking of buses and trains plays a central role.

In the case of rail transport, the district not only advocates good connections through the state, but also takes action itself: Together with the district of Böblingen, it operates the Ammertalbahn between Tübingen and Herrenberg and the Schönbuchbahn between Dettenhausen and Böblingen. Thanks to attractive interval timetables, the creation of favorable connections to the S-Bahn in the direction of Stuttgart and the use of modern and fast vehicles, it has been possible to continuously increase passenger numbers on both lines.

Education and Work

Jobcenter district of Tübingen

The Jobcenter is a institution in cooperation between the Federal Agency of Work and the district (e. g. district of Tübingen). Main tasks are to help and consult jobseekers to find work and to support them with financial ressources (Arbeitslosengeld II). This services aims to ensure subsistence, the legal basis for which is the Second Book of the Social Code (SGB II).

Services include:

Asylum Seekers' Service Act

The financial services for refugees are regulated in the Asylum Seekers' Service Act. In the district of Tübingen, asylum seekers are paid the first monthly standard rate (pro rata, if applicable) in cash upon arrival. Subsequently, at the end of each month, the asylum seekers





receive the benefits for the following month transferred or paid in cash on the last Tuesday of the month.

Education and Participation

The services of Education and Participation aims to support children and teenagers of families with low financial ressources. They are intended to contribute a successful school attendance and to enable children and young people to participate actively in sports, culture and society.

The KreisBonusCard (KBC) can be used for the entire district of Tübingen. You get discounts in many facilities of the cities and municipalities. Training Assistance (BAföG/AFBG)

Federal Training Assistance Act

The Federal Training Assistance Act (Bundesausbildungsförderungsgesetz, BAföG) supports young people in being able to complete apprenticeship. Services under the Federal Training Assistance Act (BAföG) can be granted for apprenticeships at general schools, vocational schools, technical and vocational colleges and evening schools. Training assistance is granted for training that is carried out with determination and leads to a vocational qualification. Under special circumstances, it is also possible to receive funding for a single additional course of training up to its vocational qualification.

Upgrading Training Assistance Act

The Upgrading Training Assistance Act (Aufstiegsfortbildungsförderungsgesetz, AFBG) establishes an individual legal entitlement to funding for upgrading vocational training, i.e. courses preparing for a comparable advanced training qualification. Funding is available for part-time and full-time measures for workers who are preparing for a further training qualification and have completed their initial training. Funding is provided irrespective of age.

Social welfare





Social welfare - the granting of social services to ensure a dignified existence for socially disadvantaged people - is granted in various types of assistance, which can be claimed by the individual depending on a concrete life situation worthy of support.

The following assistance services can be applied for:

- · Basic support in old age and in case of reduced earning capacity
- Assistance for nursing care
- · Integration assistance for people with disabilities

Integration

Foreigners' Registration Office

The Foreigners' Registration Office decides on residence titles applied for and issues, for example, temporary residence permits, settlement permits, EU Blue Cards or permits for permanent residence - EU. In addition, it decides in many cases on the admission of employment and monitors compliance with residence regulations in the context of visiting stays. Refugees receive residence permits here for the asylum procedure and, in individual cases, tolerations after unsuccessful asylum procedures.

Service for refugees

The employees of the service for refugees in the Landratsamt accompany and advise refugees. The specialized service mediates in social issues and provides support on the path to integration. The service is responsible for individual counseling, accompaniment and support of refugees who are assigned to the district of Tübingen. They are accompanied during and after the conclusion of the asylum procedure, always with the requirement of integration and connection to existing offers and regular services.

In addition to social counseling, the specialized service for refugees is responsible for integration management. Integration management includes joint, holistic planning for individual future prospects. This includes clearing talks and the development of integration goals.
